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Scholarship Packet

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The goal of the scholarship program at Clarksville Theological College & Seminary is to provide financial assistance to students whose heart for God, long-term commitment to the ministry, academic performance, and financial need warrant assistance from the College. We believe strongly in the personal responsibility of each student to plan for and be able to pay the cost of choosing to be a student. Further, we believe that graduates should not be hindered from fulfilling the ministry to which God has called them because of the burden of college debts; therefore, CLARKSVILLE is committed to providing quality education at an affordable cost.

General Information:

Students who are enrolled for credit, in either the Associate or Bachelor Degree programs, may be eligible for an internal needs-based scholarship. In order to qualify, students must meet the specific criteria of the scholarship they are applying for. Scholarship funds may not be applied to course audits. An awarded scholarship will only be applied to tuition and does not cover the associated expenses or fees. Only one scholarship will be awarded to eligible students (cannot double up scholarships).

Students must apply for Scholarships (Clarksville determines student's eligibility and awards scholarship based on criteria met). A student who has been awarded a scholarship must maintain a 2.5 GPA and their student financial accounts must remain current. If grades fall below a 2.5 GPA for 6 consecutive months, students risk forfeiture of their scholarship. If financial accounts become delinquent of timely payments, students risk forfeiture of their scholarship (accounts are deemed delinquent if payment is 90 days past due).

Scholarship Calculations:

Scholarship awards are determined based on the financial need of each student who applies and meets the scholarship criteria. Students who meet the specific criteria of a scholarship must submit a scholarship application to CLARKSVILLE. Once a scholarship application has been received, the reviewing committee (of no less than 3 Board members or Officers of CLARKSVILLE) will review and discuss each application and award scholarships based on eligibility and need.

Scholarships:

*** Alumni Children Scholarship**

- Awarded to single, dependent children (17-25 years old), whose parent is a graduate of Clarksville Theological College & Seminary. For a student enrolled in either the Associate or Bachelor Degree program this scholarship would reduce total tuition rate by 35%.
- Reduce total tuition rate by 35%

*** Full-Time Christian Worker Dependents Scholarship**

- Awarded to single, dependent students (17-25 years old), from immediate families in which the primary wages earned from full-time Christian Service. For a student enrolled in either the Associate or Bachelor Degree program this scholarship would reduce total tuition rate by 25%.
- Reduce total tuition rate by 25%

*** Patriot Scholarship**

- Awarded to those who have served their country in the Armed Forces and have been honorably discharged. To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must submit a notarized copy of their DD214. For a student enrolled in either the Associate or Bachelor Degree program this scholarship would reduce total tuition rate by 25%.
- Reduce total tuition rate by 25%

*** Multiple Family Member Scholarship**

- Awarded on the condition that the applicable family members are full-time students, living in the same household, matriculating at the same time and not receiving any other scholarship from the College.
- Reduce total tuition rate for 2nd student by 25%; 3rd and subsequent student(s) by 50%

At this time, Clarksville does not award grants or student loans



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Scholarship Awards and Notification:

Students are only eligible for one scholarship and will not be awarded multiple scholarships. Awards will be made in a timely manner, once received. All scholarship applicants will be notified in writing regarding the decision of their application and award amount if selected.
